
Pieced setting for Adelaide (Red Quilt)

25 ½" finished pieced frame surrounds the 6" block Fabrics required: Cream 1, Cream 3, Red 1, Red 4, Red 5, Green 1 and Green 4



Cutting

From Red 5, cut:

 $1-7\,\%$ square. Cut in half on both diagonals to form 4 E triangles.

From Green 4, cut:

 $2-7\,\%$ squares. Cut in half on both diagonals to form 8 E triangles.

From Cream 3, cut:

 $1-7\ \%"$ square. Cut in half on both diagonals to form 4 E triangles.

From Red 4, cut:

 $2-7\,\%$ squares. Cut in half on both diagonals to form 8 E triangles.

From Green 1, cut:

 $8-3\frac{1}{2}$ " C squares.

From Cream 1, cut:

 $8-3\frac{1}{2}$ " C squares.

4 – Template A triangles.

 $2-7 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut in half diagonally once to form 4 D triangles.

From Red 1, cut:

4 – Template B triangles

4 - Template Br triangles.

Star Block

Four-patch

Units are 6" finished.

Make a four-patch unit using 2 Green 1 C squares and 2 Cream 1 C squares. Press to the dark.

Make 4.

Star points. Units are 6" finished Sew a Red 1 B and Br triangle to either side of a Cream 1 A triangle. Press to the red triangles. Make 4.

Referring to the diagram for placement, sew 2 four-patch units to either side of 1 star point unit. Press to the four-patches. Make 2.

Sew the remaining two star point units to either side of the 6" block. Press to the block. Make 1.

Sew the three rows together to create an 18" finished star block.

Corner Units

For the corner units used to set this interior block on point, piece as follows.

Sew a Cream 3 E triangle to a Red 3 E triangle along the short edge. Press to the dark. Make 4.

Sew 2 Red 4 E triangles to either side of the Cream 1 D triangle. Press to the red. Make 4.


Sew a Green 4 E triangle to each end of the flying geese unit. Press to the triangles. Make 4.

Referring to the diagram for placement, sew a triangle unit to the top of the flying geese unit. Press to the triangle units. Make 4.

Sew the 4 corner units to each side of the star block to create a 25 ½" finished block.

Pieced setting for Charlie (Blue Quilt)

18" finished pieced frame surrounds the 6" block Fabrics required: Cream 6, Blue 4 and Brown 1



Cutting

From Brown 1, cut: $8 - 3 \frac{1}{2}$ C squares.

From Cream 6, cut:

 $8 - 3 \frac{1}{2}$ C squares.

4 – Template A triangles.

From Blue 4, cut:

4 – Template B triangles

4 – Template Br triangles.


Star Block

Four-patch Units are 6" finished. Make a four-patch unit using 2 Brown 1 C squares and 2 Cream 6 C squares. Press to the dark. Make 4.

Star points Units are 6" finished. Sew a Blue 4 B and Br triangle to either side of a Cream 6 A triangle. Press to the blue triangles. Make 4.

Referring to the diagram for placement, sew 2 four-patch units to either side of 1 star point unit. Press to the four-patches. Make 2. Sew the remaining two star point units to either side of the 6" block. Press to the block. Make 1.

Sew the three rows together to create an 18" finished star block.
